She is a judge on *MasterChef Junior Italy* and Italy's highly rated daily program *La Prova del Cuoco*. Her flourishing food and entertainment business includes four acclaimed New York City restaurants - *Felidia, Becco, Esca,* and *Del Posto* - and she is a partner in *Eataly*, the largest artisanal Italian food and wine marketplace with locations in New York, Chicago, Sao Paolo, Boston, and Los Angeles.

Bastianich has been named one of New York's most influential businesswomen by *Crain*'s and is a founding member of Women Chefs and Restaurateurs. She is a member of the New York City Chapter of Les Dames d'Escoffier and, in 2017, Bastianich was awarded the prestigious Les Dames d'Escoffier Grande Dame Award that honors a lifetime of outstanding professional achievement, excellence, and charitable/community contributions within the culinary industry.
